This competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations and Rules of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations and Rules of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the covered 400 m standard speed skating track

Thialf, Pim Mulierlaan 1, **Heerenveen**, The Netherlands, on artificial ice.

This competition is a regular event on the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

1 Competitions / Distances

Women and men (from age group 30) four distance competitions and single distances:

- **Sprint** (500 m, 1.000 m, 500 m, 1.000 m)
- **Allround Small** (500 m, 1.500 m, 1.000 m, 3.000 m)
- **Allround Normal** (500 m, 3.000 m, 1.500 m and 5.000 m)
- **Allround Big** (500 m, 5.000 m, 1.500 m and 10.000 m)
- **3.000 m**
- **5.000 m**
- **10.000 m**

The four distance competitions are two-days competitions. The single distances will be held on the first day of the competition. Quartet start will be used for all distances.

For the timekeeping we will use transponders. Every skater gets a set of transponders just before his/her start of every race.

2 Age Groups

This competition will be organized in the following five-year age groups (**AG** = five-year age groups Masters, Women and Men, according to their birth date, as indicated hereunder):

3 Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license of his/her federation.

4 Participation as AIN Master

ISU Communication no. 2804

The International Skating Union (ISU) Council has decided to revise the position in ISU Communication 2469 to reintroduce skaters affiliated with ISU Members in Russia and Belarus to participate in ISU Events or International Competitions during the 2026/2027 season as AIN (Neutral) Athletes ([read ISU Communication no. 2804](#)).

That means also for Master Skaters from Russia and Belarus as AIN for IMSSC competitions.

The IMSSC will follow the same process as the ISU outlined in ISU Communication no. 2804.

Procedure for Master Speedskaters from Russia and Belarus for participation as AIN

5 Limitation of participants

The competition is restricted to 108 skaters for the four distance competitions. The single distance races are restricted to 40 skaters. You will be informed as soon as possible after your entry if you can take part in the competition.

6 Drawing, seeding and classification

Digitally by the Referee on Tuesday, 16th of March 2027 and published on the website www.schaatscircuit.nl and published on the "Sportity" APP. The drawing will be done in groups of 2 skaters, according to their best times of the current season, their best times of last season or their estimated times (and in that order).

On the first two distances, for drawing purposes, skaters will be seeded in one group (women and men together) per competition (Allround (Big, Normal, Small) and Sprint), according to their best times of the current season, their best times of last season or their estimated times (and in that order).

Also, for the Single Distance Races the seeding will be done per joined Age Groups (women and men together).

Drawing at International Masters' Speed Skating Competitions will be done according to ISU Rule 244 for Drawing at International Competitions. Each of the 5 Year Age Groups is considered a separate competition in this respect.

For drawing of Masters' International Allround Competitions the ISU Rule 244 paragraph 4, 5 and 6 apply, as well as ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4. And for drawing of this Masters' International Allround Competitions the five-year age groups will be drawn (women and men together) all together. Also, the allotting of track on the third and final distance is decided by the ranking after two distances in the whole groups.

All competitors will be admitted to the last distance. An exception to this is when a competitor has received a Yellow Card from the Referee, the competitor is then excluded from the remainder of the competition (ISU Rule 275 Disqualification).

Drawing at Masters' International Sprint Competitions will be done according to ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4, with two exceptions:

- Drawing of the third and fourth distance will be done based on the overall ranking (independent of age group) on the first respectively the second distance;
 - All competitors will be admitted to the last distance.
- An exception to this is when a competitor has received a Yellow Card from the Referee, the competitor is then excluded from the rest of the competition (ISU Rule 275 Disqualification).

However final classification will be done separately in 5 years age groups independent of the number of participants in a 5 years age group.

A skater that completes all distances successfully and obtains the lowest total of points in his/her five-year age group wins the four-distance competition in her/his age group. And for the single distances: a skater that skates the fastest time in his/her five-year age group wins the single distance race in her/his age group.

7 Prices and results

There will be no prizes or a prize giving ceremony, but a certificate for all participants.

8 Anti-doping measures

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the valid ISU Anti-doping Code (ISU Communication No. 2742 or any further update of this Communication).

9 Liability

In accordance with ISU Regulation 17.3 of the *Competition & Event Regulations*, ISU, IMSSC and the Organizing Committee assume **no responsibility for, or liability with respect to, bodily or personal injury, or property damages**, incurred in connection with this competition. Each skater or accompanying person is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage here to.

10 Schedule

10.1 Competition starts

Wednesday, March 17th, 2027, **10:00h** for Allround and Sprint competitions and about **14:00h** for the single distances 10.000 m, 5.000 m and 3.000 m.

On the 5.000 m and 10.000 m every skater will have a personal lap controller.

10.2 Training and warm up times

The 400m ice track will be open for training on all public hours and on certain periods on the days before the competition. Check for details the website www.thialf.nl/openingstiiden. The admittance fee for training on public hours is not included in the entry fee of this competition.

11 Entries

Dutch competitors

Dutch competitors must register on the regular way via the website www.schaatscircuit.nl on inschrijven.schaatsen.nl.

Foreign competitors

Foreign competitors must register via the button 'Registration TRR' on the page www.schaatscircuit.nl/TRR2027 on the website www.schaatscircuit.nl.

You will get a confirmation by e-mail with a payment request, stating that your registration has been received by the Organizing Committee. However, this e-mail message does not confirm your participation. After payment has been made and received at the Organizing Committee. Confirmation of your participation can be ascertained in the Competitors' List, to be found in the Organizing Committee website: www.schaatscircuit.nl.

Entries can be made until Saturday, March 6th, 2027, at the latest.

12 Entrance fee for competitors

Entrance fee will be:

- 66,00 euro** for Sprint (500 m, 1.000 m, 500 m, 1.000 m)
- 102,50 euro** for Allround Small (500 m, 1.500 m, 1.000 m, 3.000 m)
- 135,00 euro** for Allround Normal (500 m, 3.000 m, 1.500 m and 5.000 m)
- 170,00 euro** for Allround Big (500 m, 5.000m, 1.500 m and 10.000m)
- 42,50 euro** for 3.000 m
- 56,50 euro** for 5.000 m
- 77,50 euro** for 10.000 m
